India's GDP grew 7.6% in July-September quarter, higher than RBI MPC projection.

India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) registered an impressive growth of 7.6% in the July-September quarter, according to the government data released on Thursday. It was 5.4% in the same quarter last year. It is much higher than the projection of the Reserve Bank of India's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) last month. In the first quarter of 2023-24 (FY24), India's GDP grew by 7.5% in the second quarter in a row. The jump in GDP figures in the second quarter was led by the manufacturing and construction industries.

Walmart shifts to India from China for cheaper imports as it cut costs

Walmart is diversifying its supply chain by increasing imports from India and reducing its reliance on China, shipping a quarter of its U.S. imports from India compared to just 2% in 2018, while sourcing 60% from China, down from 80% in 2018. This shift reflects efforts to mitigate risks, cut costs, and tap into India's manufacturing capabilities, driven by factors like geopolitical tensions, rising costs in China, and the need for more resilient supply chains amidst global uncertainties like the pandemic and geopolitical conflicts.

India is nearing an agreement with Tesla, contemplating allowing the US automaker to import electric cars from next year and potentially build a factory within two years, possibly to be announced at a summit in January. Tesla could invest around \$2 billion initially and expand purchases of auto parts from India to \$15 billion, aiming to manufacture batteries in the country. This move comes as India seeks to boost domestic EV manufacturing, but the EV market remains modest due to high upfront costs and inadequate charging infrastructure.
